



## NSLA Collaborative Lending Principles

- We are aiming to open collections, both physical and electronic, and enable greater access to the rich resources of the National, State and Territory libraries by making materials available through document delivery.
- We are bound by copyright, licensing and donor considerations that govern access to certain materials.
- Original material will be lent via the creation of surrogates. We support the creation and dissemination of surrogates whenever originals cannot be made available within the constraints of copyright, licensing and donor considerations.
- We have a preference towards delivery of digital copies and digital delivery.
- The physical condition of an item may affect the availability for loan or copy and will be at the discretion of the host library
- Categories of lending should not be dependent on the age of material.

## Categories of Lending

Serials	Allow	Serials at article level via creation of surrogate In library use for bound serials
Sheet music	Allow	If a lending copy or via creation of a surrogate
Pictorial	Allow	Via creation of surrogate
Ephemera	Allow	Via creation of surrogate
Microform	Allow	
Film	Allow	Via creation of surrogate
DVD's/Videos	Allow	Via creation of surrogate
Motor manuals	Allow	Lend or library use only
Government publications	Allow	Lend or via creation of surrogate
Statistics	Exempt	
Standards	Exempt	
Maps	Allow	Via creation of surrogate, dependent on equipment availability and ability to charge cost of creation of surrogate
Unbound pamphlets	Allow	Via creation of surrogate
Bound pamphlets	Allow	Via creation of surrogate
NSFA	Allow	Dependent on NFSFA conditions
Vinyl sound recordings	Exempt	
Audio visual multi media kits	Exempt	
Music CDs	Allow	
CD Roms	Exempt	
Loose leaf publications	Allow	Via creation of surrogate In part creation of surrogate
Multi volume sets	Allow	Defined via charging policy
Newspapers	Exempt	
Legal deposit copy	Allow	Via creation of surrogate
Only copy	Allow	Except if it falls into one of the other categories defined
Rare and valuable	Allow	Via creation of surrogate
Special named and formed collections	Allow	Via creation of surrogate
Monographs less than a year old	Allow	
Oral history	Allow	Via creation of surrogate if the individual library has the capacity to create the surrogate
State-iana/heritage collections	Allow	Via creation of surrogate
Original materials	Allow	Via creation of surrogate
Fragile items	Allow	Via creation of surrogate
